REGULAR COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES September 14, 2016 @ 9.00 a.m. Village Office- 904 Central Avenue

1) The meeting was called to order at 8:50 am.

- 2) <u>Present:</u> Commissioners; Chair, Brian Banks, Heather Parker, Bob Baker, Don MacDonald & Staff Marian Elsworth, Clerk-Treasurer
