10) New Business:

- A. <u>Financial update:</u> Comparative Income Statement November 2016, 2015 and 2014. MOVED/SECONDED by Commissioner Sealby and Baker that the comparative income statement be accepted. CARRIED.
- B. <u>Culvert for Central Avenue near Sobeys (Bob)</u>: Commissioner Baker explained to the commission about a low area near Sobeys that is in need of a culvert. He received a verbal quote but it may be too late in the season to install. It was MOVED/SECONDED by Commissioners Baker and Parker to go ahead with installing a catch basin, once permit is issued by DTIR, for an estimated cost of up to \$1,500.00. CARRIED.
- C. <u>Canada Day (Heather)</u> The Canada Day committee has been working on the plans for Canada Day 150 and a meeting will be held on January 11 at 7 pm at the New Beginning Centre, with potential participants invited.
- D. <u>Rocknotch Sidewalk Extension:</u> An email was received from Scott Peckford, Rydel Homes. He asked if the village commission had any short or long term plans to extend the Rocknotch Road sidewalk. Commissioner Parker MOVED/SECONDED by Commissioner Sealby that: We extend the Rocknotch Road sidewalk as a second priority after the Tremont Mountain Road sidewalk is completed. CARRIED.
- E. Comments on Rezoning Whittington Drive and Central Avenue: An email was received from Mark Fredericks, GIS planner County of Kings regarding file # 16-16, an application to rezone a portion of property (PID # 55511075) at the corner of Whittington Drive and Central Avenue in Greenwood. He requested input from the village commission. Commissioner MacDonald MOVED/SECONDED by Commissioner Baker to support the application to rezone PID #55511075, File # 16-16. CARRIED.
